ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION

The House of Generations is an institution of mixed social services. Residents of different ages find shelter in them: elderly people, young mothers, and their children (40 places for elderly people and 11 places for mothers with children). This institution provides day center social care services for the elderly in the "Day Center for the Elderly" (the center can accommodate up to 25 people), as well as general social services for women and children who have moved out of the Kaunas family home.

TASKS

The volunteer will assist in organizing various activities for different client groups:

- Caring for the elderly;
- Teaching a foreign language or computer literacy to elderly day visitors;
- Helping young mothers with children acquire daily life skills (preparing lunch, shopping, caring for children);
- Helping to organize events for all residents or visitors.

MAIN FOCUS OF OUR WORK

The main goal of our organization is to provide social care and social services for our elder residents and mothers with their children who are in a crisis situation. We are in a unique organization where both the elders and mothers with their children live under one roof, learn from each other and support one and other.



PRACTICALITIES

- Volunteering app. 30-35 hours/week
- Accommodation in a private room in a shared apartment
- Monthly ticket for public transport
- Monthly food and pocket money
- On-arrival and mid-term trainings
- Volunteer group meetings once/a month and regular meetings with coordinators and mentor
- Online or face-to-face Lithuanian language classes
- Organizing and participating in events, discussions, workshops
