Equação has received the quality label for ESC and Erasmus+ accreditation for Youth (that intends to systematize our performance in terms of mobility of young people and workers in the youth area) with regard to the themes that we defined in our strategy for the next decade:

- 1. More supportive and sustainable projects

In 2009 our local member (Aventura Marão Clube) started to manage the local youth centre/hostel, Casa da Juventude de Amarante (CJ Amarante), a study case project as it was the first private body managing a public equipment like this in Portugal. CJ Amarante's initial strategy was to support local youth initiatives to approach youngsters to our values, develop mobility and participation projects and offer accommodation and food services).

Equação main objectives are:

- Promotion of Fair-Trade PRINCIPLES in Portugal;
- Promotion of SOLIDARY values by bringing volunteering and solidarity to the daily life of the community;
- Development of personal, social and professional SKILLS (young people, volunteers, collaborators, partners);
- SUSTAINABLE practices that seek to present life alternatives to participants and the community.





About the project

"NATURAL" is an ESC Volunteering project with 1 Coordinating Organisation (Equação, crl from Portugal) and 5 volunteers coming from 5 Supporting Organizations from EU Program and Partner Countries to develop activities during 12 months (365 days)/each volunteer in Amarante (Portugal).

Conditions

POCKET MONEY:

The "Pocket money" to the volunteer for additional personal expenses according to the ESC Guide 2025 is a contribution of 6€/day per volunteer.

HEALTH INSURANCE

You will be insured by the Henner Insurance Plan and receive their personal membership card.

FOOD AND ACCOMMODATION:

Equação has a long experience with ESC and Volunteering Projects and our policy for food and accommodation is this:

- Accommodation will be in an apartment or house (both in Amarante's city center and nearby the youth centre) or also at Youth Village, where usually we host our volunteers. These places are well equipped with rooms, bathrooms and kitchen (laundry is for free in the youth centre). In some cases volunteers might have to share rooms double rooms.
- Food (breakfast, lunch and dinner) Will be given from Monday to Saturday (6 days per Week) by our organization at the youth centre (Casa da Juventude de Amarante) Where usually We serve meals to our volunteers. Food is vegetarian (including also eggs, milk, seitan, tofu, mushrooms, etc.). In one day of the Week Will be provided one non vegetarian dinner. Besides that We Will give 40€/month to each volunteer to organize own meals at Sunday (We pay according to invoices given by volunteers).



Amarante

Amarante is a historical city in northern Portugal With a huge natural and building heritage. The cultural and artistic tradition made Amarante a Creative city of UNESCO network. With around 56 thousand inhabitants, Amarante is the municipality with the biggest area of the Porto district.
