# What is ENTAR?



ENTAR is a youth exchange that helps young people develop entrepreneurial skills, creativity and self-confidence through learning by doing. Participants will create business ideas, work on marketing strategies, take part in the Start-up Challenge and design educational board games about entrepreneurship. Each national team will also lead its own workshops, strengthening leadership, teamwork, and communication skills. Through international cooperation and practical activities, ENTAR encourages young people to become entrepreneurial changemakers.

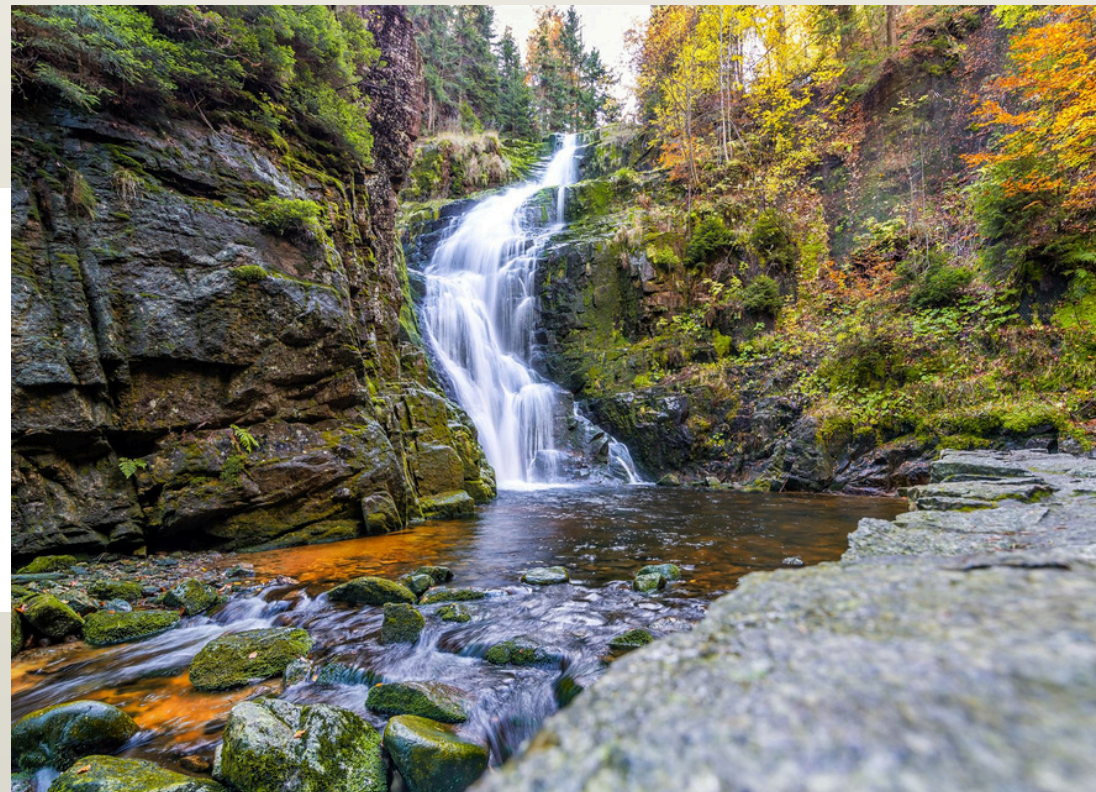

# Accommodation



Address: **Pensjonat Zameczek, ul. Piastowska 39, 58-580 Szklarska Poręba**

You will be accommodated in 3-4 person rooms with private bathrooms. Szklarska Poręba is one of the most popular mountain resorts in Poland, known for its beautiful landscapes, waterfalls and breathtaking views. Our venue is around 4 km from the city center, the nearest shop is around 1,5 km.



# Arrival information



When choosing your airport, we highly recommend flying to Wrocław Airport. The best way to reach Szklarska Poręba is by train using Koleje Dolnośląskie (regional train company). Please choose the station Szklarska Poręba Dolna.

From the station, it is around a 15-minute walk to the accommodation. You can also travel to Szklarska Poręba by bus (e.g. Flixbus). After arriving, you can use local public transport – bus line L1 to the Szklarska Poręba Dolna stop (the driver sells the tickets).

You can also find a flight to Prague, Poznań, Katowice or Kraków.



# What to bring?

- Comfortable clothes and shoes for outdoor activities.
- Minimum 3 laptops per country.
- Snacks, national flag and traditional clothes for the intercultural evening.
- Personal hygiene items (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, slippers, pajamas, etc.).
- Medication - if needed.
- The currency in Poland is the Polish Złoty (PLN). Bring some cash with you, as in many places card payment may not be available. The nearest ATM and exchange office are far from the accommodation.
